All walks are graded - easy, moderate or hard - and the team at the Tourist Information Centre will be happy to answer any questions and help you plan and book your walks.

## Walking Grades:

#### **EASY**

Easy stroll on road and path, generally level walking, no hills.

#### **MODERATE**

Fairly easy walk on paths but some will be uneven and narrow. There will also be some inclines; or some walking on beaches.

#### **HARD**

Fairly strenuous, several inclines/some hills and uneven, narrow paths (or when there is a beach landing off a boat); walking at a slightly faster pace.

We estimate that most of the all-day walks (roughly 10.30am – 4.30pm with a lunch stop) are probably in the region of 5 or 6 miles.

#### ST. MARY'S





# **Keeping Scilly Special**

### **BIRDS ON SCILLY - BREEDING SEASON**

### A word from the Isles of Scilly Wildlife Trust:

Scilly is regionally, nationally and in some cases internationally important for breeding sea and coastal birds; from Manx shearwater to storm petrel, puffin to the lesser black-backed gull; many return to their breeding grounds on our Islands year after year. As a result of this, and to give our sea and coastal birds the best possible chance of rearing young, a number of our uninhabited islands are closed all year around and others, both uninhabited and inhabited, have areas of restricted access during breeding season (between April and September).

Please respect these restrictions, and if you are walking a dog near these areas please ensure that you keep it under control.
